I am writing on behalf of Chief Carl in response to your public records request wherein you seek certain records regarding the Framingham Police Department's SWAT team. I predict that the response will encompass approximately 500 computer printed pages at a rate of \$.50 per page for a total of \$250.00 in production costs. Due to the scope of the request, I further estimate that it will take 10 hours of search and redaction time at a rate of \$52.58 per hour. This is the SWAT Team Commander's hourly rate. I further estimate that it will take 15 hours of the SWAT Team's Executive Officer's time, at a rate of \$55.93 per hour. Thus, the total estimated cost associated with the production of the requested records is \$1,615.75. Finally, I estimate that it will take the Department several months to produce the requested items.
