

I wanted to keep you in the loop on the matter noted below.

The BI2 Technologies bid for the Facial Recognition Technology Upgrade and Expansion is \$148,000+. This figure will leave a balance of the Grant available to use for additional Vendor services – provided the added services relate specifically to the purpose of the federal Grant.
