

All,

I had an additional thought on an idea I proposed at the meeting regarding the enrollment process which uploads the new photos to the central database each time new pictures are taken. Currently, the quoted time frame for the upload was 1-2 minutes and as expressed by myself and others, the concern was that it would take too long to process multiple inmates. I proposed that the system have the option to do a store and forward where you could process multiple inmates and then upload them at a later time.

After more thought on the matter, I feel that there is no reason why the application could not store all the pictures as a default and then process a batch file overnight on a scheduled basis. Based on the purpose of the enrollment, to share the data with other agencies, this should not cause a problem because in most cases, other agencies would not be needing this data immediately as these new photos would be taken during the booking process at our facilities. With the exception of a few reasons, I cannot see a local police department, as example, trying to recognize an individual in-between the time his photo was taken at our facility and the time it would be uploaded that evening.

Please let me know what you think of this reasoning in regards to a nightly batch file process. As my background is more on the IT side of things and not the law enforcement side, please let me know if there are more instances than I can think of when the data would truly need to be uploaded immediately to be readily available to other agencies.

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



When you return, I would like to get together for an informal Project review – Project Update-of-Status discussion; nothing to formal; just a dot the "I" and cross the "t" type of details review.


Two questions I do wish to get into circulation and consideration by the BI2 Team:
