We can take the similar approach as we had implemented for Barnstable County's IRIS interface -

Send inmate demographic data and image files to Facial Recognition Server -

1. In SIRS, users initiate the files submission process by pressing the Send to Biometric button on the Admin. -> Inmates Configurator screen
- 2.

On clicking "Send to Biometric" button, staging tables within SIRS will be populated with the inmate's demographic information. And a process reads these staging tables to generate a text file (.txt format) for demographic data and image files (.JPG format) for inmate's facial and Marks Scars and Tattoos photos which will be transmitted via FTP over to the facial recognition server 3. Demographic data file name and image file names will be unique and prefixed with <person_id>_<booking_id> for example -

Demographic data file --> <person_id>_<booking_id>.txt

Photos Files -->

Front Profile --> <person_id>_<booking_id>_MFXX0000.JPG

Left Profile --> <person_id>_<booking_id>_MLXX0000.JPG

Right Profile --> <person_id>_<booking_id>_MRXX0000.JPG

Marks --> <person_id>_<booking_id>_SAXX0000.JPG..... SAXX0001.JPG.....
