Statement of Work for MBHSR Mobile Command Response Vehicle

The City of Boston, Office of Emergency Management (OEM), on behalf of the Metro Boston Homeland Security Region (MBHSR), is requesting a quote to be made under Massachusetts Statewide Contract FAC64 Category 2, for the following:

- One-year contract to rent services of a mobile command response vehicle for both <u>planned</u> <u>events</u> and <u>unplanned incidents</u> within the MBHSR (Boston, Brookline, Cambridge, Chelsea, Everett, Quincy, Revere, Somerville, and Winthrop).
 - Vehicle must be able to be deployed to any of these communities.
 - Vehicle must be available for OEM-requested planned events as well as emergency responses to unplanned incidents.
- Vehicle components should include:
 - o Ability to access the MBHSR camera network and gunshot detection system.
 - o Ability to access (wireless) for other A/V equipment such as laptops and other devices.
 - Seating for no less than 6 staff.
 - Vehicle should *not* include unmanned aerial device capabilities.
- Price components should include:
 - One flat-rate per event/incident, where "event/incident" can range from a few hours to multiple days.
 - o The flat rate should be all-inclusive.
 - Quote should reference pricing made under FAC64 Category 2.
- The City of Boston OEM reserves the right to negotiate and modify requirements with the awarded Contractor.

- 1. Descriptive narrative overview of the features offered in the vehicle and what the response time would be for unplanned incidents.
