On Wednesday February 22nd 2017, I received information from Dispatch regarding a potential identity theft situation stemming back to the early 1990's involving a male party named who now resides in North Carolina. The reporting party, works and owns a company called NC and assists persons who have issues with their respective driver's licenses.
I spoke to over the phone and she advised me of the following:
stated she has been helping a man named (DOB SS#) with fixing issues pertaining to his NC license status. Stated 'cannot obtain a driver's license in NC where he has now moved, because his identity was stolen many years ago and used all over the country, including Massachusetts. States she has contacted the MSP Fusion Center inquiring about any licenses that could be in mame. The Fusion Center advised contact us here at the Sturbridge Police.
I entered name and date of birth into CJIS and found that this exact name, DOB, and SS#, are one of many of aliases which appear to have been used many times in the past years. These aliases are attached to BOP record. I also located an expired MA driver's license under with the same SS# as the OLN, which is what was used back in the 1990's as the OLN in MA. This license was expired in 1994 as well as Revoked for a bad check to the MA RMV. There is no picture attached to this license as it is very old. The license shows an address out of MA, and a P.O. Box in MA. lives at in I believe this driver's license under was obtained by in the 90's and used until his incarceration in 1996. The driver's history of this MA license under stops in 1996 with what appears as a bad check to the MA RMV. 1996 is the year was convicted of felony possesion of a firearm and sentenced to 17 years in Federal Prison. A look at current driver's history is very short, considering his extensive past history of crimes and motor vehicle violations.
I advised that it could be possible dentity was stolen by a man who lives here in Sturbridge at this time. Sent me a copy of dentity was stolen by a man who lives here in Sturbridge at this time. These items were verified by a Notary Public in NC. I checked in NC and located a color photo of him. BOP history shows he was born in NY, which coincides with the first three digits of his SS#, asked if I could be certain dentity was used by this person in Sturbridge, and I advised I would need to further investigate the matter before making a certain determination. I also advised to have her client, go to the local police department there in NC and request they take finger prints electronically. I advised this would then prove was not in any way, and this evidence could be used later to clear his name of any wrong doing. The prints are on file with the FBI, since he has been arrested multiple times over the years.
I called the Massachusetts Board of Probation Department, inquiring if they were able to see when and where used the see that and may have used the name then. BOP Department was unable to determine when arrested in the past.
I contacted the Brookline Police and requested any and all police reports pertaining to either

I was directed to the RMV's Enforcement Services Section, where I called and spoke to an employee. I asked if there were any way to locate an old photo for the old MA license and I was advised the old photos were not digital, but actual printed photos. I was advised the MA RMV could potentially link the two driver's licenses if there was sufficient evidence to show that did in fact obtain a driver's license unlawfully, thus making responsible for his actions many years ago under a false name. I advised them that I had evidence used name when arrested years ago and this information was on BOP record. The RMV Enforcement Services employee referred me to the Facial Recognition Division of the RMV where they might be able to locate an old photo and compare it to current photo. He told me to call back if they could do a facial recognition, and they would open up their own investigation into the matter. I called the Facial Recognition Division and left a message.
