## UNCLASSIFIED//LAW ENFORCEMENT SENSITIVE

RIFC Services
CARFAX: Valuable historical vehicle history reports can assist you in uncovering VIN cloning, replating, auto theft, odometer discrepancies and more. Get instant notifications when activity is reported to CARFAX for any VIN of interest. Search and view accident reports from any participating agency across the country.
CLEAR: Powerful search tools provide access to comprehensive, current information, including cell phone and VoIP data; real-time entity resolution improves query results; flexible, configurable reports; charting and mapping features
Cross Agency: A system that checks all participating RI Law Enforcement Agency's record management systems. This is a pointer index system only and does not provide reports. This check is only available to those Agencies that do not have access to Cross Agency. (Out of State and Federal Agencies)
CrimeNtel: Criminal intelligence database populated from intelligence and information forwarded to the RIFC. Can be searched by name, offense, vehicles, and other associated information
DMV Photo or Lineups: Digital photographs from DMV can be retrieved and sent electronically; lineups can also be conducted using the same photographs (photo lineups are available, but take approximately 24 hours).
eGuardian: A sensitive but unclassified version of the FBI's Guardian Threat Tracking System
EPIC: Information regarding narcotics trafficking and interdiction
*Federal Databases: Personnel from DHS and FBI are assigned to the RIFC and can run names through their internal databases. **MUST MEET THRESHOLD- CALL RIFC**
*FinCEN: Financial Crimes Enforcement Network (FinCEN) provides information on any Currency Transaction Reports (CTRs), Suspicious Activity Reports (SARs), or any other type of financial report that may be filed on a subject possibly involved in suspicious activity **MUST MEET THRESHOLD- CALL RIFC**
INTERPOL: Information on wanted international subjects, stolen travel documents, and missing persons abroad
*ISO ClaimSearch: Insurance industry's "All Claim Database", which includes property and casualty claims data along with vehicle related information through the National Insurance Crime Bureau (NICB). Access is restricted to the purpose of "investigating vehicle theft and insurance related crime or for developing background information on individuals who have been identified as a person of interest with regard to homeland security activity.
JABS: Information from federal booking and arrest records
Pawn Shop Database: Check on items pawned and subject(s) who pawned them
RISSNET: Intelligence, gang information, leads, etc., database using the regional centers such as NESPIN
TLO: Online investigative system that uses advanced search capabilities into massive and unique data repositories
Winfacts: Rhode Island corrections database
Other: The RIFC maintains contact with all local law enforcement agencies in Rhode Island, state agencies, Fusion Center and/or intelligence units from all other states and the District of Columbia, and federal agencies. If assistance is needed from other agencies, the RIFC is able to reach out to their contacts to request and receive the needed information
