This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) appeal dated July 25, 2012, which you submitted on behalf of the American Civil Liberties Union of Massachusetts. Your original request was assigned FOIA Case Number TSA10-0782 in which you requested copies of any documents describing the potential use of thermal imaging technology to detect illness at Logan Airport.

Your request was processed under the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552. The Transportation Security Administration responded on June 12, 2012, and informed you a comprehensive search was conducted and no responsive records were located. You filed an administrative appeal challenging the adequacy of the search conducted by TSA.

My review of the FOIA search conducted confirms that the search was accurate, complete and in compliance with FOIA requirements. Therefore, I am denying your appeal.

Fees


The fees incurred to process your request do not exceed the minimum threshold necessary for charge and, therefore, there are no fees associated with processing this request.
