This letter is in response to your public records request, dated January 13, 2011 and received by this office on January 18, 2011, made pursuant to the Massachusetts Public Records Law, G.L. c. 66, § 10. You requested copies of records held by the Office of the Attorney General (AGO), specifically nine (9) categories of records related to our office's issuance of G.L. c. 271, § 17B administrative subpoenas.

As we discussed in our conversation earlier this week, we are currently in the process of identifying and reviewing records that may be responsive to your request and subject to disclosure under the public records law, G.L. c. 66, § 10 and G.L. c. 4, § 7, cl. 26. You will be notified as soon as possible of the results of our efforts, and whether there is a cost associated with producing responsive records that are not otherwise exempt from disclosure.
