As the next step in the MA Facial Recognition project we would like to verify that the test images you supplied are suitable for actual recognition of the test subjects.

I would like to come to Hampden County and photograph several of the inmates you had uploaded as test subjects for the MA Facial Recognition project and run them against the test database we have established.

I would like to come out either Wednesday or Thursday this week to get this process rolling.

To accomplish this I will need to either get my notebook on your network with internet access or alternately use a pc at your location with internet access. I would need to hook up a web cam to take the pictures. The ideal situation would be that you have our PSS product installed with a web cam.

Please let me know when is best for me to come on site and what is available for us to perform this test.

We have run this test with several departments already with good results. Once we establish that the mug shots you have provided are suitable for performing a recognition against the database then we will ask you to upload the bulk of your remaining photos and demographics to populate the database.

We have encountered a question that requires your consideration and guidance.

Please read George Connolly's email below regarding the photos that are contained in the SIRS database. Based on what George has been told by SIRS, this will require significant and unanticipated time, effort and costs for us, as well as the SIRS IT staff, to export, import and convert the SIRS records.

As a result of this delay, our final implementation schedule has changed and is dependent on the decision in this regard because, as noted below, George has been in frequent contact with officials at Essex County (where the server will be located) and they obviously need (and want) their photos from SIRS to be included in their implementation.

I have heard back from Ajay (SIRS) relative to converting the existing photos and demographic data from SIRS to the MA Sheriff's Facial Recognition system.

He was concerned about the amount of time and effort it would take to export all SIRS records to the Facial system.

We talked about perhaps providing a sub set of the records, for example, all currently housed inmates or all inmates booked this year rather than doing a complete dump of all the historical records.

I am seeking your advice on what you would like to have converted from SIRS. If you insist on a full historical dump then I think there would be some negotiation necessary to convince SIRS to expend this effort.

Let me know where to go from here.
