- **Welcome/Introductions**
  - Deirdre opened the meeting at 10:35 am
- **FFY 14 Project Updates**
  - Grant Expires 7/31/16
  - U14-3.1 – Intelligence Analysts - \$553,597.95 remains to be expended
  - \$124,446.63 will need to be reallocated as funding will not be spent before end of grant year. The subcommittee recommended reallocating funds to U14-3.3-Hardware/Software for the following projects:
    - PenLink for Boston PD/BRIC - \$88,726.39
    - HD Digital Cameras for Chelsea PD - \$7,247.70
    - Digital Sandbox COOP - \$22,500
  - U14-3.2 – Geospatial Analysis Platform Phase 3 - \$147,945.55 expended
  - U14-3.3 - Hardware/Software - \$187,498.74 has been expended. See above for reallocations from U14-3.1
- **FFY 15 Project Updates**
  - U15-3.1 – Intelligence Analysts – \$1.5M funds will begin drawing down in August 2016
  - U15-3.2 – Social Media & Regional Analytics - \$300,000. Jurisdictions have submitted their requirements. RFP under development.
  - U15-3.3 - Hardware/Software - \$569,000 includes critical A/V upgrades for the BRIC, CLEAR service and Geospatial mapping components for FATPOT.
  - Travel/Training priorities include analyst attendance at IACA in Louisville in September.
- **FFY 16 Allocations**
  - U16-3.1 – Intel Analysts - \$1,500,000
  - U16-3.2 – Social Media & Regional Analytics - \$300,000
  - U16-3.3 – Hardware/Software - \$474,000 (see attached list) Including \$40,000 for mobile cameras
