The Middlesex Sheriff's Office will be hosting COPLINK training at their Training Offices at [REDACTED] in May 4, 2018 from 8:30am - 9:30 am.

This session is being conducted by [REDACTED] PD who handles all of the SWISS and COPLINK start-ups across the Commonwealth. It is an abbreviated COPLINK training session and not as comprehensive as that provided by The Commonwealth Fusion Center, however all of the features will be discussed.

Coplink is free statewide database integration and access for law enforcement to gather and view police reports. You will also be able to build photo arrays and use facial recognition to identify suspects. COPLINK is a valuable tool because instead of checking people only by BOP, you will be able to see police involvements whether they are a victim, witness, suspects or associates, etc.

Currently 280 cities and towns across the Commonwealth contribute to and use this free service. The technology has developed and advanced greatly over the past few years and now includes facial recognition. It would be beneficial for Detectives, Patrol Officers and Dispatch Operations.

COPLINK also has a mobile app that participants will be taught how to use. **THIS TRAINING WILL BE HELD AT THE MIDDLESEX SHERIFFS OFFICE TRAINING ACADEMY, [REDACTED]** The training will take about one hour and is free.

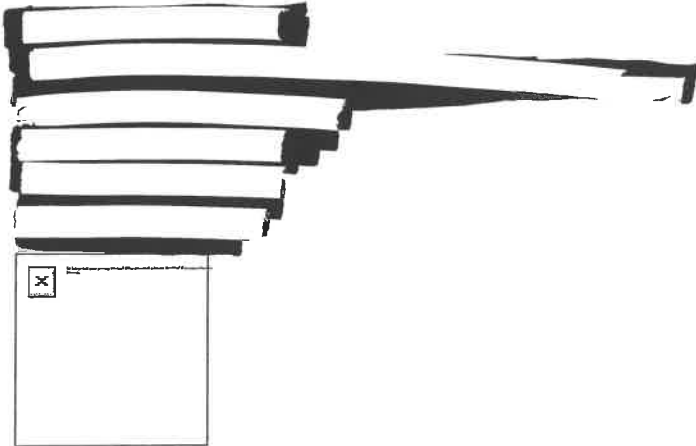

## FREE Training for Police and Dispatchers – CopLink

On Thursday September 21<sup>st</sup>, Marblehead Police will be hosting a free CopLink training in the [REDACTED] located at [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] on behalf of the Commonwealth Fusion Center will be providing a roughly one hour training course on how to log into and utilize the CopLink system.

Information sharing is key to protecting law enforcement officers and the public and CopLink is a power tool in the process.

COPLINK is free statewide database integration and access for law enforcement to gather and view police reports. You will also be able to do photo arrays and use facial recognition to identify suspects. COPLINK is a valuable tool because instead of checking people by BOP you will be able to see police involvements whether they are a victim, witness, suspect etc. Currently 280 cities and towns across the Commonwealth contribute to and use this free service provided by the State Police Fusion Center. It is free for you to use. The technology has developed and advanced greatly over the past few years and now includes facial recognition. As it is designed for both, the Detective Division, patrol and Dispatchers will benefit in its use. COPLINK also has a mobile app that you will be taught how to use.

COPLINK can also be used for background investigations for new employees

In addition to the free training, the commonwealth pays for CopLink and there are no short or long term expenses to the departments on the network. The only cost will be to send your officers and dispatchers to the roughly one hour course.

Check in will commence Thursday September 21<sup>st</sup> at 08:00hrs with the class starting at 08:30 and running till roughly -09:30ish.
