Dear Emiliano:

The City of Boston (City) has received your request for public records. This response applies only to records that exist and are in the custody of the City. See A Guide to the Massachusetts Public Records Law, p. 32, n.115. It is expected that a custodian of records must use her superior knowledge of her records with respect to responses to public records requests. 950 CMR 32.04(5). Specifically, you stated:

ACLUM seeks records pertaining to the sharing of video surveillance data, including but not limited to any interagency memorandums of understanding (“MOUs”), like the ones highlighted in page five of Exhibit A.

This request includes:

- 1. All memoranda of understanding, memoranda of agreement, and any other agreements, informal or formal, between City of Boston agencies and departments pertaining to video surveillance.*
- 2. All memoranda of understanding, memoranda of agreement, and any other agreements, informal or formal, between the City of Boston (to include all subdivisions and agencies) and outside local, state, and federal agencies pertaining to video surveillance.*
