# To All OPLA Personnel:

As you know, last year Secretary of Homeland Security Alejandro Mayorkas issued a memorandum titled, *Guidelines for the Enforcement of Civil Immigration Law* (Sept. 30, 2021), which took effect on November 29, 2021 and set forth the Department of Homeland Security's (DHS's) civil immigration enforcement priorities. In accordance with the Secretary's guidelines and guidance from <u>DHS General Counsel Jonathan Meyer</u>, on April 3, 2022, I have signed and am issuing now a memorandum, titled *Guidance to OPLA Attorneys Regarding the Enforcement of Civil Immigration Laws and the Exercise of Prosecutorial Discretion*, which provides direction to OPLA attorneys on implementing the DHS civil immigration enforcement priorities and exercising prosecutorial discretion (PD). This new OPLA memorandum will take effect on April 25, 2022 and, at that time, will rescind the interim guidance issued by former Principal Legal Advisor John D. Trasviña, *Interim Guidance to OPLA Attorneys Regarding Civil Immigration Enforcement and Removal Policies and Priorities* (May 27, 2021).
