On Tuesday May 5, 2020 an inspection of the conduits/tunnels beneath the parking lot and the building at Leverett Circle (Old H-4) was conducted. The inspection was deemed a success, if only because I was not included in the video portion. Lt. Michael George forwarded the link to the video, which can be accessed below. The determinations of its condition and repairs deemed necessary will be forthcoming. In furtherance of this project, I feel it would be a good idea to collect and share the images of the H-4 Transformation from its existing condition throughout construction until opening new doors. Documentation of the construction project is already being done by both the construction company and the architectural firm assigned to the project.

It is the opinion of this officer, as well as others affiliated with this project, that perhaps the MSP can find the proper venue to house and view the progression of the build. This would hopefully include documents and pictures of the building in its infancy from the previous century, up to the day we moved to Birmingham Parkway and concluding the day MSP returns to Leverett Circle. Mike George suggested a camera set to create time-lapse progression and Dave Crouse is already looking into the options to set up a camera. Mike is also planning drone flights to capture video progression of the build.

I think that collecting and storing these images now is important, coupled with an easily accessible website on which to view them. This would be a great morale booster for the MSP, those looking to return to that historic location, or to be among the first of the new classes to step foot in the building. I am certain that those who will work there will be looking to be the first to book their arrest in the new H-4.

It is my understanding that the next phase of the project could be as early as mid-June, 2020. If that is accurate, it is important to set this project in motion and create a site easily accessible to MSP members and capable of holding the photographs, video, and documentary entries to be made. From this collection of historical and progressive data, periodic updates can be produced, culminating with a final product for display.
